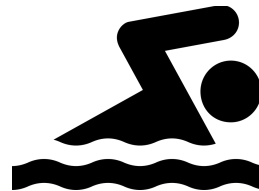

General Information cont'd...

Students -you are required to have your Student ID badge with you at all times. There are entirely too many students coming to the office without their ID badge. You will no longer be buzzed in, and will not be allowed to access the school through the Counseling Center. If you have lost your ID badge and need a replacement, you will need to see Mrs. Dessecker in the attendance office and pay the \$10 replacement fee. STUDENT ID BADGES ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES FOR SCHOOL SAFETY.

This is an important announcement for all 17- and 18-year old men. We want you to remember that when you turn 18, it's the law that you register with Selective Service. Registering with Selective Service is your civic responsibility and keeps you eligible for student loans, job training, government jobs, and drivers licenses in most states. All of that will be very important to you soon.



So get a Selective Service registration card at your local post office or register online at www.sss.gov. You can even do it with your smartphone now. If you have any questions regarding registration talk to a Selective Service registrar or your guidance counselor.

The late bell is at 8:00am. Be sure to make it to class on time to start the day.
